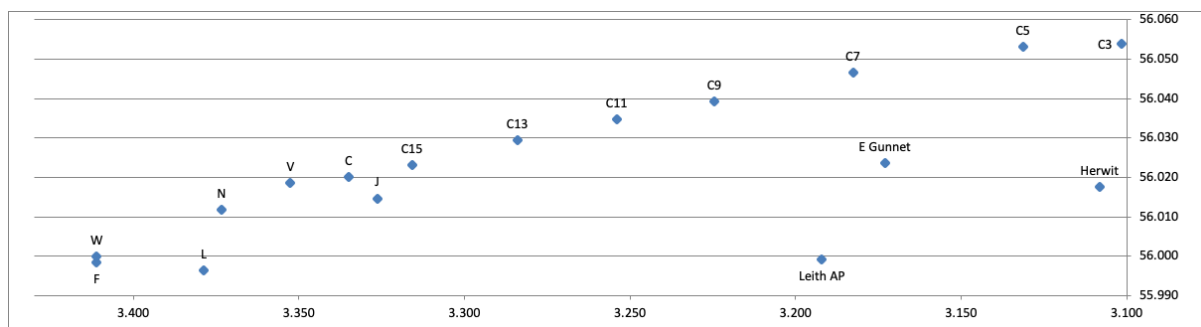


PEYC Yacht Trophy Courses - May 2023

Notes:

- Courses for Div-3 & Div-1 will be selected such that the slowest yacht should complete its course within 5 hours in the forecast conditions. If there are insufficient entries to justify separate races, both Divisions will sail the same course with staggered starts at the scheduled times and elapsed times combined into a single result.
- Race Officer signalled start from PEYC Race Box line at Port Edgar, passing west to east.
- Finish passing mark F to starboard, self-timing to nearest second as mark bears due north.
- Send finish time to PEYC Sailing Secretary at jim@scott-mail.co.uk within one week.
- Protests must be submitted to the PEYC Sailing Secretary within one week of the race.
